First Baptist Church is now offering a new and convenient way to facilitate and simplify giving. This new financial service will be very cost effective. It will maximize the use of every dollar shared with our ministry. The new option is: **electronic funds transfer (EFT)**.

This service has been around for many years. It is widely used in the banking/ financial world and is now being introduced into many Christian and charitable non-profit organizations. The reasons for this are:

- ~ Increased savings for both donor and recipient
- ~ Increased convenience in giving
- ~ Increased security of the donor's investment
- ~ Increased consistency in overall giving

Some answers to questions about Electronic Giving

Question: What is electronic giving?

Answer: Electronic giving is an automatic withdraw from your checking or savings account.

Question: What are the advantages of electronic giving?

Answer: It saves time! It saves work! It saves money! It is the safest way to transfer money! It simplifies life! You can avoid the trouble of writing and mailing checks!

Question: How can you transfer money from my account?

Answer: Only with your authorization.

Question: When is the electronic gift transferred from my account?

Answer: Funds will be withdrawn each Tuesday or the 1st Tuesday of each month depending on whether or not you choose to give weekly or monthly donations.

Question: If I do not write checks, how do I keep my checkbook straight?

Answer: Since your gift is made at a pre-established time, you simply record it in your check register on the appropriate date.

Question: Without a canceled check, how do I prove I gave my gift?

Answer: Your monthly bank statement gives you an itemized list of gifts you've given. Also, First Baptist Church of Doylestown sends you a yearly receipt.

Question: Is electronic giving safe?

Answer: Electronic giving is much less risky than giving by check. It cannot be lost, stolen, or destroyed in the mail. It has an extremely high rate of accuracy.

Question: What if I change bank accounts?

Answer: Notify us and we will give you a new authorization form to fill out.

Question: How much does the electronic giving service cost?

Answer: It costs you nothing. Plus you save the cost of stamps, checks, and envelopes. It saves First Baptist money too!

Question: What if I try electronic giving and I don't like it?

Answer: You can cancel your authorization by notifying us at any time.
